### How St Paul's Cathedral was saved in the Second World War.

An illustrated talk at All Saints Church on **Saturday July 15th at 3pm**. The fact that St Paul's was hit by bombs but did not burn down and continued to remain open became a symbol for Londoners during the blitz of "togetherness, survival and suffering". The raid of the 29th and 30th December 1940 was the 114th night of the Blitz and

became known as the "Second Great Fire of London" .

Come and hear David Morse tell us about the volunteer St Paul's amateur Fire Watch teams and how they saved the Cathedral.
