## York Supplies : a very Kings Heath response

York Supplies is a hardware and gardening store that serves the community (and the earth) by selling what people need in the quantity they need – just one nail, if that's all they want. It helps reduce waste by enabling people to mend things.

The current owner is retiring, so the community has come together to save York Supplies. It has formed a Community Benefit Society so the store can be owned by all who invest in it. The minimum investment is £100. It needs to raise £300,000 by 7 September 2023.
