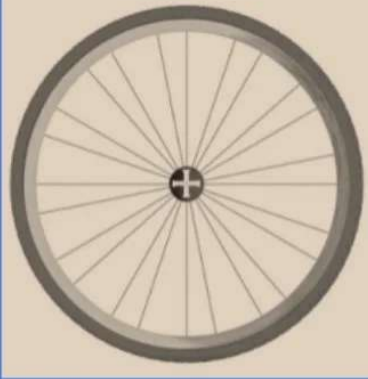
Margaret Shepherd's Funeral
