7.30 Wednesday Evenings in the Chapel Room concluding with Compline at 9pm, from Wednesday 21st February. We will resume after and Easter break.

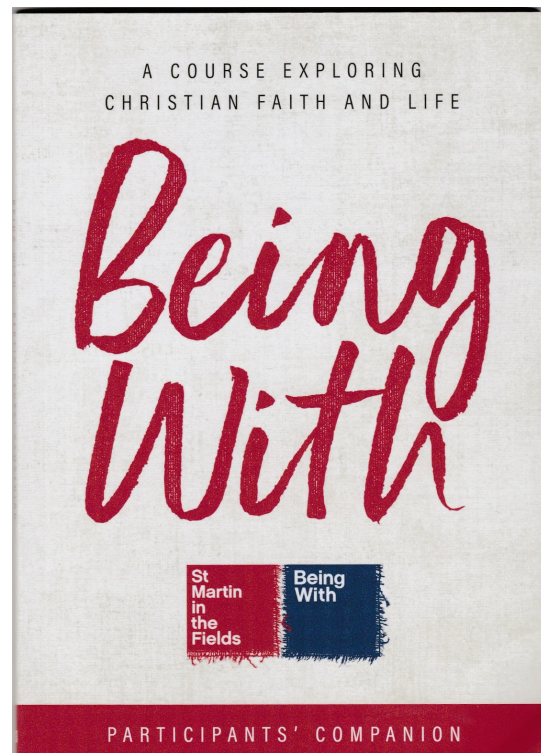
