We will let you know as soon as we have settled on the date for Gill's service.

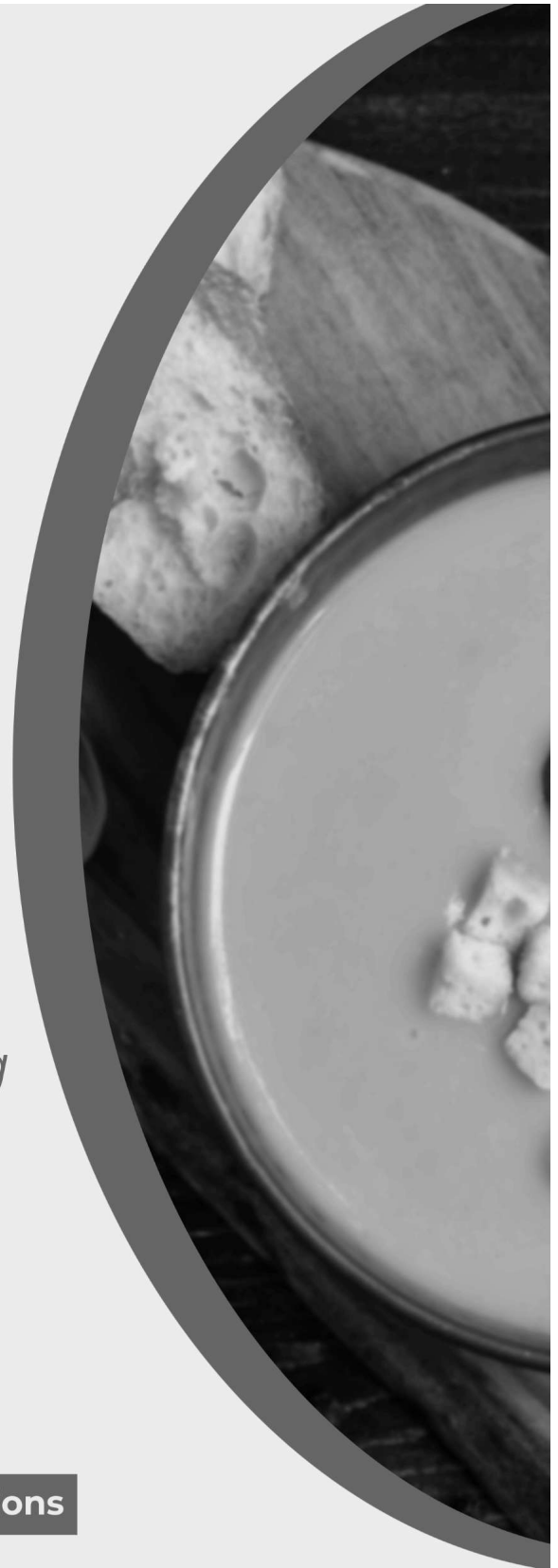
